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


Funding Activity Results

Community Meeting 4 was held on Wednesday, June 12th, 2019. The meeting previewed the South Division Corridor Plan to the community. There were approximately 50 attendees, including a few first-time participants. Each participant received \$10,000 in "Division Bucks" to fund their favorite project ideas. **This graph shows the projects people funded most.** "Develop a Storefront Improvement Program" was the most funded project, with "Credit Union" and "Facilitate Home Repair" also receiving high levels of funding.

The top 5 projects are listed to the right; these top-ranked projects will receive further concept development within the Corridor Plan, followed by the ten remaining concepts developed by the Working Groups, and then the larger pool of project ideas that may be further developed through plan implementation.

Top 5 Most "Funded" Priority Projects

Funds / Project

- \$56K** **Develop a Storefront Improvement Program**
 Develop a program that focuses on both façade improvements for new and existing businesses as well as window programs and other efforts to mitigate the appearance of vacant storefronts.
- \$54K** **Recruit a Credit Union or Minority-Owned Bank**
 Focus on the importance of a bank or credit union as an asset to the community, considering financial incentives and other approaches to attract an institution that could provide necessary financial resources.
- \$38K** **Facilitate Home Repair and Improvements**
 Facilitate home repair and improvements through education, services, and model programs. Create a clearinghouse of home repair and financial education services and take other steps to empower home owners.
- \$37K** **Develop and Support a Variety of Community Events**
 Support the creation of events that emphasize diversity and appeal to all ages, encouraging unity and togetherness within the South Division neighborhoods.
- \$34K** **Advocate for Changes to City and State Policy**
 Advocate for changes to City and State Policy that align with the outcomes of the Plan and that maximize eligibility of South Division properties for incentive programs.
